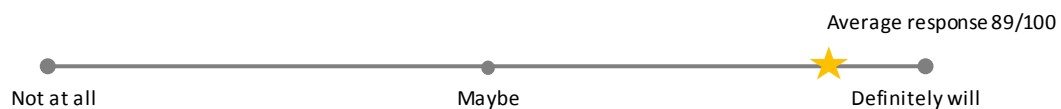

Q1. How would you rate the session you attended?

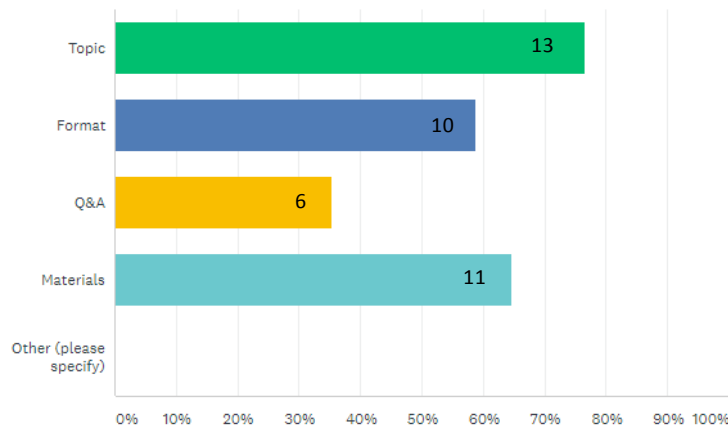

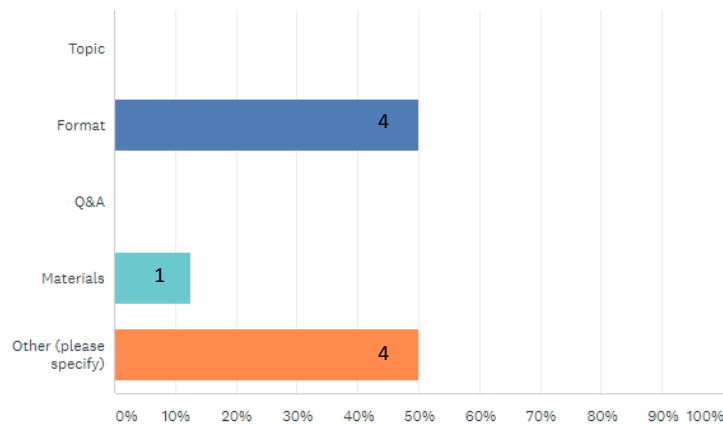
Q2. How likely would you be to recommend this session to a colleague?
