BYLAW NO. 1371, 2020

A bylaw to amend the Yarrow/Ryder Lake Fire Protection Service Area

WHEREAS *Fraser Valley Regional District Electoral Area E Yarrow/Ryder Lake Fire Prevention and Suppression Local Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 0230, 1988* was adopted by the Fraser Valley Regional District Board of Directors ("the Board") on October 27, 1998;

AND WHEREAS the Board deems it necessary to amend Bylaw No. 0230, 1988 to recognize the division of the former Electoral Area E of the Fraser Valley Regional District into Electoral Areas E and H in accordance with Order in Council No. 501, approved and ordered on September 5, 2014 and Letters Patent effective December 17, 2014 issued by the Province of British Columbia;

AND WHEREAS consent on behalf of the electoral participating areas of the Fraser Valley Regional District has been obtained as per the *Local Government Act*;

THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Fraser Valley Regional District enacts as follows:

1) **CITATION**

This bylaw may be cited as the *Fraser Valley Regional District Yarrow/Ryder Lake Fire Protection Service Area Amendment Bylaw No. 1371, 2020*.

2) **ENACTMENTS**

That Fraser Valley Regional District Bylaw No. 0230, 1998 be amended by:

- a. deleting all references to "Electoral Area E" and replacing them with "Electoral Areas E and H";
- b. deleting Section 2 and replacing it with the following:
"The Fraser Valley Regional District hereby establishes a service area for the purpose of providing fire protection within portions of Electoral Areas E and H, to be known as the "Yarrow/Ryder Lake Fire Protection Service Area ";
- c. deleting Section 4 and replacing it with the following:
"The boundaries of the service area established by this bylaw shall be those portions of Electoral Areas E and H as shown on Schedules 1371-A and 1371-B attached to and forming an integral part of this bylaw."
- d. Deleting Schedules 0230-A and 0230-B and substituting them with Schedules 1371-A and 1371-B attached hereto and forming an integral part of this bylaw.

3) SEVERABILITY

If a portion of this bylaw is found invalid by a court, it will be severed and the remainder of the bylaw will remain in effect.

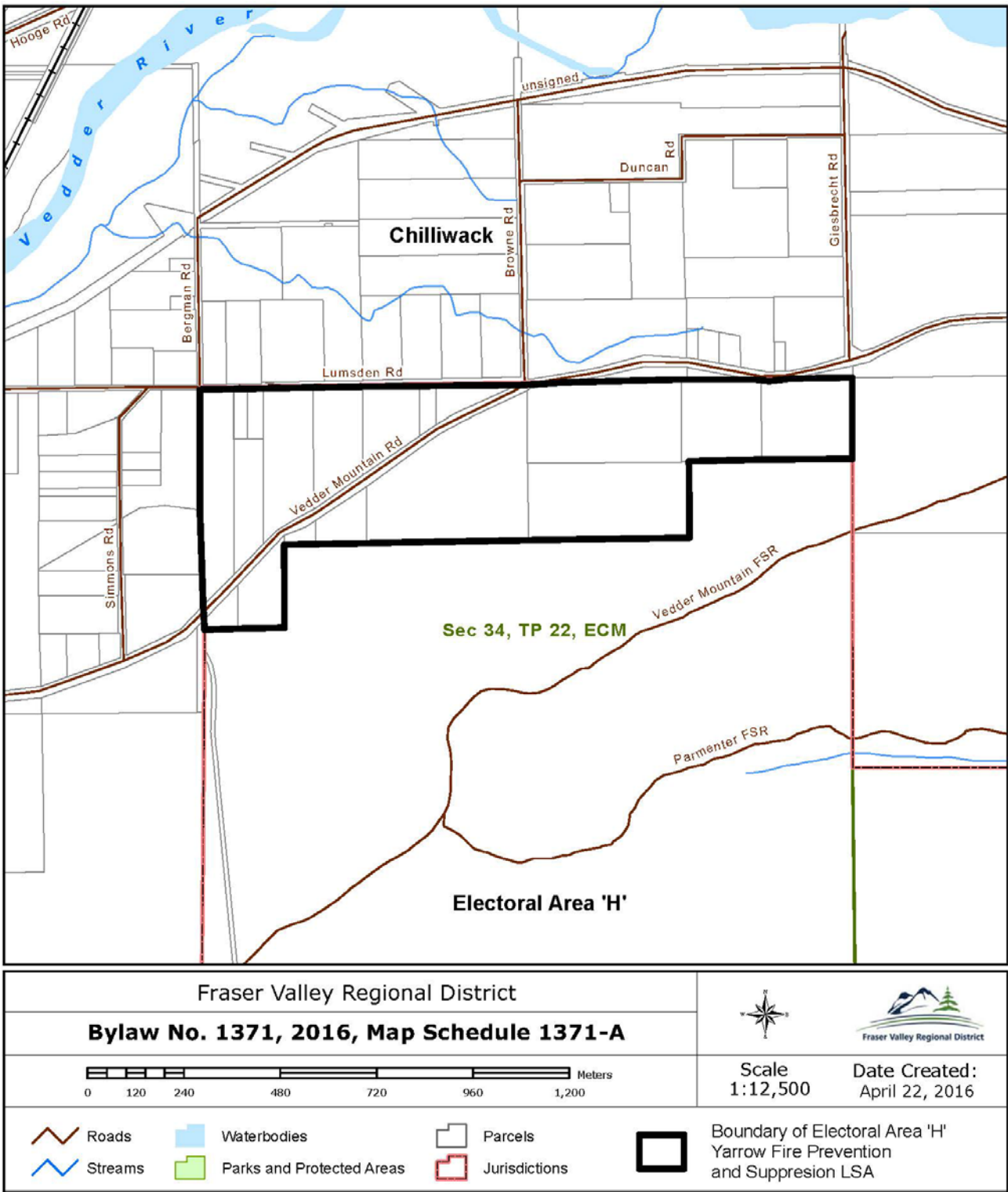

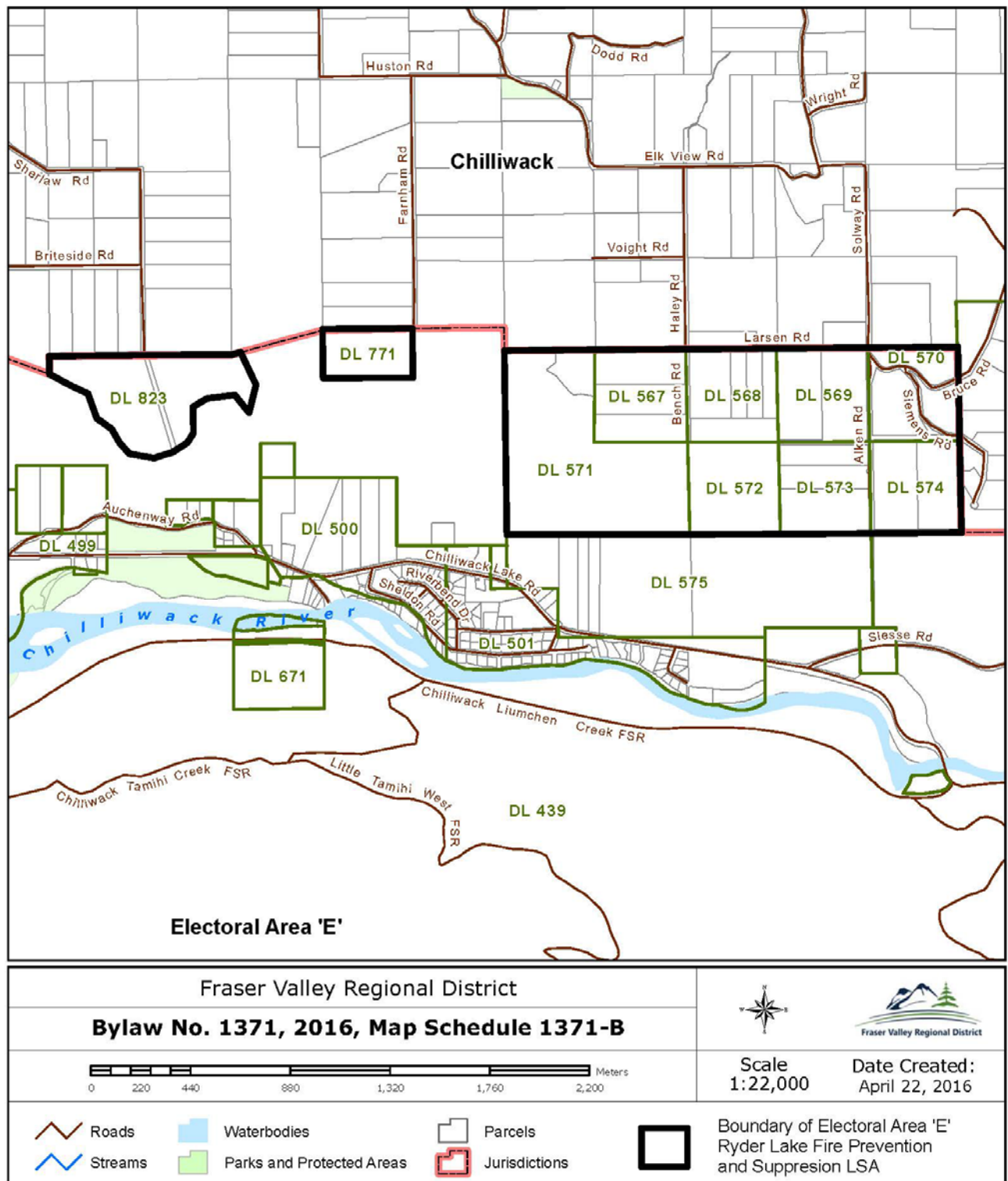
