BYLAW NO. 1610, 2020

A bylaw to amend the Parkview Street Lighting Service Area Establishment Bylaw

WHEREAS the *Parkview Street Lighting Local Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 1208, 1994* was adopted by the Regional District of Fraser-Cheam Board of Directors on February 7, 1995;

AND WHEREAS the Fraser Valley Regional District Board of Directors ("the Board") deems it necessary to amend Bylaw No. 1208, 1994, as amended, to recognize the division of the former Electoral Area E of the Fraser Valley Regional District into Electoral Areas E and H in accordance with Order in Council No. 501, approved and ordered on September 5, 2014 and Letters Patent effective December 17, 2014 issued by the Province of British Columbia;

AND WHEREAS consent on behalf of the electoral participating areas of the Fraser Valley Regional District has been obtained in accordance with the *Local Government Act*;

THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Fraser Valley Regional District enacts as follows:

1) <u>CITATION</u>

This bylaw may be cited as the Fraser Valley Regional District Parkview Street Lighting Service Area Amendment Bylaw No. 1610, 2020.

2) <u>ENACTMENTS</u>

That Fraser Valley Regional District Bylaw No. 1208, 1994 be amended by deleting all references to "Electoral Area E" and replacing them with "Electoral Area H".

3) <u>SEVERABILITY</u>

If a portion of this bylaw is found invalid by a court, it will be severed and the remainder of the bylaw will remain in effect.
