BYLAW NO. 1613, 2020

A bylaw to amend the Cultus Lake Seasonal Conventional Transit Service Area Establishment Bylaw

WHEREAS the Fraser Valley Regional District Cultus Lake Seasonal Conventional Transit Local Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 1084, 1992 was adopted by the Fraser Valley Regional District Board of Directors ("the Board") on November 17, 1992;

AND WHEREAS the Board deems it necessary to amend Bylaw No. 1084, 1992 to recognize the division of the former Electoral Area E of the Fraser Valley Regional District into Electoral Areas E and H in accordance with Order in Council No. 501, approved and ordered on September 5, 2014 and Letters Patent effective December 17, 2014 issued by the Province of British Columbia;

AND WHEREAS consent on behalf of the electoral participating areas of the Fraser Valley Regional District has been obtained in accordance with the *Local Government Act*;

THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Fraser Valley Regional District enacts as follows:

1) **CITATION**

This bylaw may be cited as the Fraser Valley Regional District Cultus Lake Seasonal Conventional Transit Service Area Amendment Bylaw No. 1613, 2020.

2) ENACTMENTS

That Fraser Valley Regional District Bylaw No. 1084, 1992 be amended by deleting all references to "Electoral Area E" and replacing them with "Electoral Area H".

3) **SEVERABILITY**

If a portion of this bylaw is found invalid by a court, it will be severed and the remainder of the bylaw will remain in effect.
