The Emergency Program Act "provides the legislative framework for the management of disasters and emergencies in British Columbia." It outlines the responsibilities of local governments. In particular, it provides the authority for local governments to declare a State of Local Emergency, in addition to requiring local governments to develop and maintain emergency management plans and programs to respond to disasters, emergencies, and catastrophes.


