Recruitment

To date in 2024, the FVRD has issued three (3) postings for open positions within the organization. The chart below shows the recruitment statistics for the past five years. In some cases, a position may be posted multiple times in a given year, as there can be higher turnover for these positions. For example, part-time recreation positions (e.g. lifeguard) typically have multiple recruitments.
