Cultus Lake Day is an annual community event that is open to the public. It is set to be held on June 22, 2024, and includes a range of family-friendly activities including a parade and the opportunity for community members to participate with the creation of their own float. It also has a pancake breakfast (managed by the Cultus Lake Volunteer Fire Department), a children's fun area, live music, and a vendor's market. This highly popular event (an estimated 10,000 people attend each year) provides the opportunity for residents of Cultus Lake Park and the FVRD, along with visitors to the region, to visit the Park to kick off summer and enjoy family-friendly fun outdoors.
