RECOMMENDATION

THAT the Fraser Valley Regional District Board give three readings and adoption to *Fraser Valley Regional District Repeal (Cultus Lake Sewer Connection and Regulations) Bylaw No. 1784, 2025*.

BACKGROUND

Recently, the Board of Directors adopted the Fraser Valley Regional District Sewer Systems Regulations, Fees and Charges Establishment Bylaw No. 1768, 2025. This bylaw provides the terms and conditions in which the six (6) community sewer systems owned by the Fraser Valley Regional District (FVRD) may be operated as well as specifying the user fee rates. In order for Bylaw No. 1768, 2025 to supersede all existing sewer system regulations and fees bylaws they must be repealed.

DISCUSSION

All the existing sewer system regulations and fees bylaws have been repealed with the exception of the Cultus Lake sewer system bylaws. Staff are recommending repealing Regional District of Fraser Cheam Cultus Lake Specified Area Sewer Connection and Regulation Bylaw 253, 1980, so the Cultus Lake sewer system regulations and fees bylaws may be replaced with the Fraser Valley Regional District Sewer Systems Regulations, Fees and Charges Establishment Bylaw No. 1768, 2025.

COST

There are no costs associated with repeal of this bylaw.
