RECOMMENDATION

THAT the Fraser Valley Regional District Board give three readings and adoption to the bylaw cited as Fraser Valley Regional District Electoral Area D Integrated Water System Service Area Amendment Bylaw No.1785, 2025

BACKGROUND

Staff have received a validated petition from a property owner requesting that the boundaries of the Electoral Area D Integrated Water System Service Area be amended and extended to include their property.

DISCUSSION

The owner of 53355 Yale Rd has submitted a validated petition to amend the boundaries of the Electoral Area D Integrated Water System Area. The property is zoned Rural 3 and contains one single-family dwelling.

A water service connection to this property was previously installed but never used. The owner has paid to have the service retrofitted with a water meter.

COST

No cost to the FVRD

The property owner has paid to have a water meter installed and has paid the \$2,037.04 Area D Water System DCC.
