ADDITIONAL INFORMATION....

The Canadian Archery Challenge:

This is a community-oriented alpine 3D archery event – the only one of its kind North of the border. The event introduces an unparalleled 3D archery experience set against the stunning backdrop of Sasquatch Mountain Resort and the Canadian wilderness. The event offers lift access to two immersive archery courses, providing participants with a weekend full of excitement. Designed with families in mind, this event features a variety of activities beyond archery ensuring fun for all ages. There will be exciting prizes, live music, archery ranges, and exhibitor booths.

The event aims to establish a premier archery experience North of the border.

Where will the event take place?

The event will take place within the boundaries of Sasquatch Mountain Resort ski area, in two well marked and controlled areas and either through lift access or hiking. This will be on the Yeti side of the mountain primarily – directly below the Yeti unload station and to the right of the run called Mainline.

Camping.

Overnight camping will be available for families and participants. This is supplemental to the event and offered on behalf of Sasquatch Mountain Resort. All campers will be required to be Self-Contained – meaning no water or power hook-ups available. There will be no open fires permitted – only propane fire pits permitted.

Campers will have complete access to the day lodge for any needs that may arise including the use of bathroom facilities for the duration of the event. Fresh drinking water will also be available for them from the lodge.

Security and Crowd Control.

Through Sasquatch Mountains normal measures – which include ski patrol (working on foot for the event), volunteers provided by the Canadian Archery Challenge, and with the assistance of local volunteers and first aid attendants – the crowd control and security will be maintained in similar fashion to a typical ski season day(s). Cordoned off areas will be developed to prevent and deter people and participants from wandering too far from the event epicenter (the Day Lodge) and patrolled by volunteers and ski patrol members.

The RCMP will be made aware of the event and are part of the Emergency Preparedness Plan developed by Sasquatch Mountain Resort for all on-mountain activities throughout the year.

Addendum to Application Form:

Hours of Operation: this is an all-day, 24 hour camping event running from 5:00pm on Friday June 20, 2025 until 3:00pmm on Sunday June 22, 2025.

Participants: the event is expected to draw some 250-300 participants and families over the course of the event. We anticipate a portion of these participants – somewhere between 25-40 – will partake in the available camping space. The remaining participants will be utilizing the on-mountain housing rentals available and off-mountain accommodations including Sandpiper Resort and the Sasquatch Inn, to name a couple. Others still may camp at at the various Provincial and private campgrounds in and around Harrison Mills.
