MAP/SITE PLAN INFORMATION

Location A:

- Day Lodge Area. Includes all washroom facilities; food and beverage; office areas
- Working off our existing water supply and utilities.
- We have more than sufficient supply and facilities to accommodate the number of people attending the event for the entire duration of the event.

Location B:

- Limited overnight, self-contained camping sites. Each camper must have own gen-set and water storage on unit.
- No hook-ups.
- Garbage and recycling cans will be placed throughout the location.
- Clean-up crew will ensure all trash is removed from site and placed in garbage bins to be removed from resort by Valley Waste.

Location C:

- Main parking area. NO OVERNIGHT CAMPING PERMITTED.
- Parking will be managed by Sasquatch Mountain Resort.
- There will be no parking outside the main parking area.

- Main access to the resort is up Hemlock Valley Road.
- Washroom facilities including men's and women's designated – multiple stalls and sinks including sanitation areas.
- Garbage disposal units will include round and square "portable" garbage cans and then dumped in large, removable, slide-off bins supplied by Valley Waste.
- All water is supplied through HVU (Hemlock Valley Utilities) as per usual operation during the ski season.
- All cooking facilities are within the existing day lodge including main kitchen and serving areas, and seating.
- First aid will be supplied by Canadian Archery Challenge and Sasquatch Mountain Resort. Level 1, OFA Level 3, and EMR on site for entire event duration.
- Fire Protection is through the Hemlock Valley Volunteer Fire Department. NO OPEN PIT BURNING IS PERMITTED. Propane fire pits only.
