RECOMMENDATION

THAT the Fraser Valley Regional District Board give three readings and adoption to the bylaw cited as Fraser Valley Regional District Electoral Area D Integrated Water System Service Area Amendment Bylaw No.1792, 2025

BACKGROUND

Staff have received a validated petition from a property owner requesting that the boundaries of the Electoral Area D Integrated Water System Service Area be amended and extended to include their property.

DISCUSSION

The owner of 53195 Yale Rd has submitted a validated petition to amend the boundaries of the Electoral Area D Integrated Water System Area. The property is zoned Rural 3 and contains one single-family dwelling.

The owner has paid to have a service and water meter installed.

COST

There is no cost to the FVRD. The property owner has paid for a service and water meter installation and has paid the Area D Water System DCC.
