### RECOMMENDATION

**THAT** the Fraser Valley Regional District Board give three readings and adoption to the bylaw cited as Fraser Valley Regional District Bylaw Offence Notice Enforcement Amendment Bylaw No. 1808, 2025.

### BACKGROUND

Fraser Valley Regional District Bylaw Offence Notice Enforcement Bylaw No. 1415, 2017 requires updating with respect to the adoption of the Fraser Valley Regional District Electoral Area B Garbage Collection Regulations and Fees Establishment Bylaw No. 1800, 2025.

### DISCUSSION

Fraser Valley Regional District Electoral Area B Garbage Collection Regulations and Fees Establishment Bylaw No. 1800, 2025 regulates Garbage, Recycling and Organic Waste disposal. Adding this bylaw to the Bylaw Offence Notice Enforcement Bylaw will allow for the issuing of fines for contraventions of the garbage disposal bylaw.

The Fraser Valley Regional District Bylaw Offence Notice Enforcement Amendment Bylaw No. 1808, 2025 provides for the addition of the following penalty amounts for Fraser Valley Regional District Electoral Area B Garbage Collection Regulations and Fees Establishment Bylaw No. 1800, 2025.
