

FRASER VALLEY REGIONAL DISTRICT
BYLAW NO. 1789, 2025

A Bylaw to amend the West Popkum Storm Drainage Service Area by merging it with the East Popkum Drainage Service Area and the Popkum Drainage Service Connection Service Area

WHEREAS *Regional District of Fraser-Cheam Popkum West Storm Drainage Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 888, 1990* was adopted on February 19, 1991;

AND WHEREAS *Fraser Valley Regional District East Popkum Storm Drainage System Local Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 0228, 1998* was adopted on August 25, 1998;

AND WHEREAS *Fraser Valley Regional District Popkum Drainage Service Connection Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 1321, 2015* was adopted on January 26, 2016;

AND WHEREAS the Fraser Valley Regional District Board of Directors (the "Board") wishes to merge the Service Areas established by the above noted bylaws into one service area to be known as the Fraser Valley Regional District Popkum Storm Drainage Service Area;

AND WHEREAS consent on behalf of electoral participating areas has been obtained;

THEREFORE the Board enacts as follows:

1) CITATION

This Bylaw may be cited as *Fraser Valley Regional District Popkum Storm Drainage Service Area Merger and Establishment Bylaw No. 1789, 2025*.

2) ENACTMENTS

- a) The services established under *Fraser Valley Regional District East Popkum Storm Drainage System Local Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 0228, 1998* and *Fraser Valley Regional District Popkum Drainage Service Connection Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 1321, 2015* are hereby transferred and merged with the service established under *Regional District of Fraser-Cheam Popkum West Storm Drainage Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 888, 1990* and the name of the newly merged service area shall be known hereafter as the Fraser Valley Regional District Popkum Storm Drainage Service Area;
- b) The participating area for the service established by this bylaw shall be Electoral Area D of the Fraser Valley Regional District.
- c) The boundaries of the service area established by this bylaw shall be that portion of Electoral Area D as shown on Schedule 1789-A attached to and forming an integral part of this bylaw. For clarity, numbered highways are not included in this service area.

- d) The annual costs for the service established by this bylaw shall be recovered by one or more of the following:
 - i. The requisition of money to be collected by a property value tax;
 - ii. The imposition of fees and other charges that may be fixed by separate bylaw for the purpose of recovering these costs.
 - iii. Revenues received by way of agreement, enterprise, gift, grant or otherwise.
- e) The maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually for the service established by this bylaw shall be an amount equal to that which could be raised by a property value tax rate of \$0.0995/\$1000 applied to the net taxable value of the land and improvements within the service area.

3) **SEVERABILITY**

If a portion of this bylaw is found invalid by a court, it will be severed and the remainder of the bylaw will remain in effect.

4) **REPEAL**

Fraser Valley Regional District Area D Rosegarden Estates Storm Water Drainage Service Area Fees and Other Charges Establishment Bylaw No. 1327, 2015 is hereby repealed.

5) **READINGS AND ADOPTION**

READ A FIRST TIME this 23rd day of October, 2025

READ A THIRD TIME this 23rd day of October, 2025

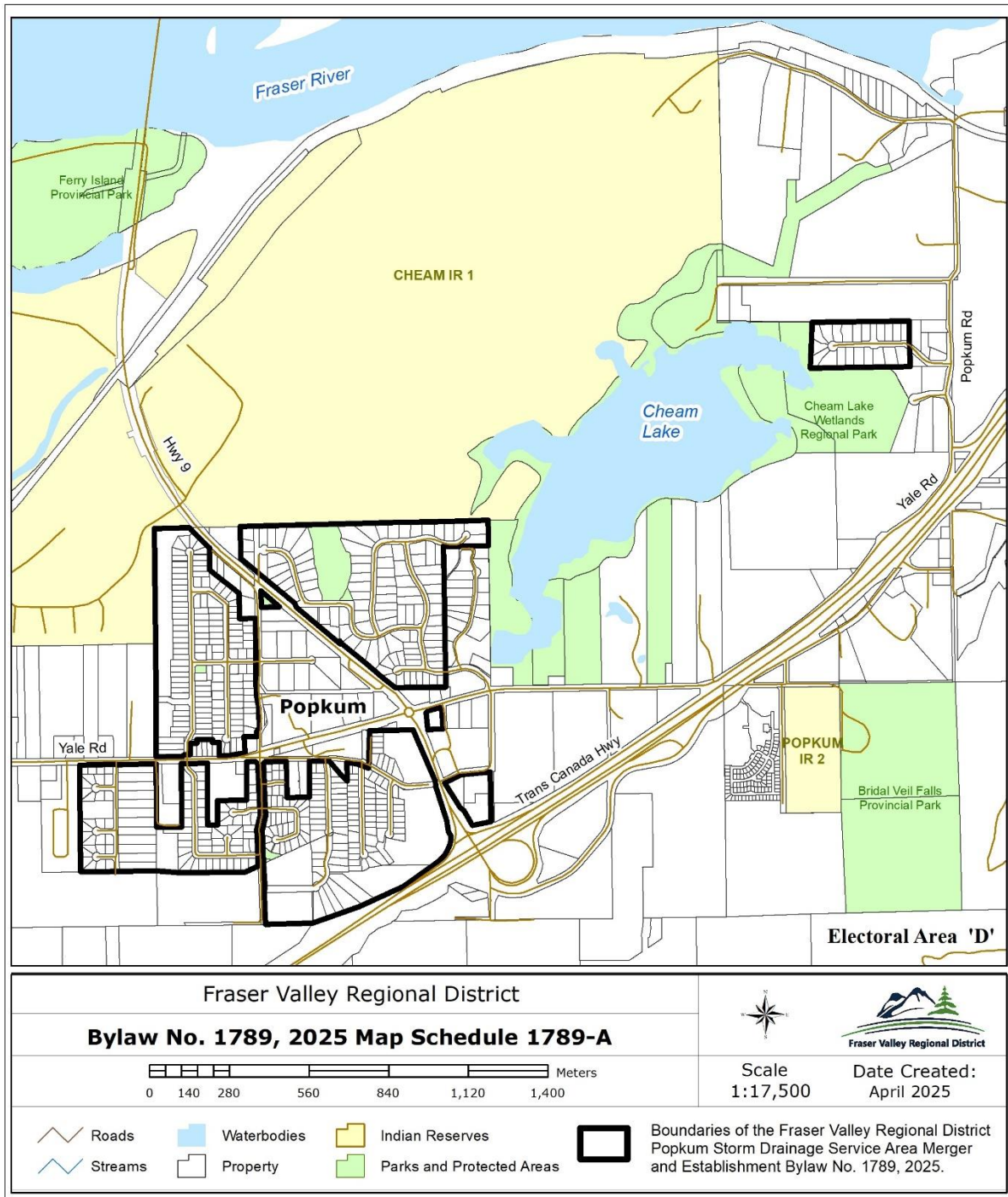
